



Vancouver Exam Venue JLPT Test Day Checklist

1. Test Voucher

- Bring your **PRINTED test voucher** on the test day (We will NOT provide printed test vouchers for those who do not bring their own)
- Check that your name, test level, test site are correct.

2. Photo ID

- Bring a valid photo ID for identification (e.g. driver's license, student ID with a photo or passport)
- Make sure your name, date of birth, and photo are clearly visible.

3. Stationery and Personal Items

- HB or B Pencils (Mechanical pencils are not allowed / Pencil sharpeners will not be provided, so please bring enough sharpened pencils with you)
- Eraser (Please remove the eraser case, as it has Japanese writing on it)
- Please limit the number of personal items you bring to the test site
- Bring **only one** mobile phone
- I will **not bring any other electronic devices** (including smartwatches and earphones).

4. At the Test Site

- Check your transportation route and travel time to the test site in advance.
- Your Mobile phone will be collected as soon as you enter the building.
- Keep your test voucher and photo ID ready to show at the entrance.
- Confirm the check-in time and do not arrive earlier than instructed.
- The doors will remain closed after the check-in time has ended, and no one will be allowed to enter for any reason.
- There will be no waiting area for parents or guardians inside the test venue.
- Your photo ID will also be checked inside the classroom before the test begins. Please **keep your photo ID with you until the test is finished.**
- For anti-cheating purposes, we may ask test takers with masks, hats, or hair covering their ears to show their faces.
- If your address has changed, please complete and submit the form at the Information Update Desk on the test day
- Some people are sensitive to strong scents, so we kindly ask all test takers to avoid using perfume or heavily scented products.
- There will be a waiting time between check-in and the start of the tests.
The waiting time will take place in the hall. While waiting in the hall, you are still considered to be inside the test site, so all electronic devices must not be used in accordance with the Japan Foundation's regulations.
