

Vancouver Exam Venue JLPT Test Day Checklist

1. Test Voucher

- Bring your **PRINTED test voucher** on the test day (We will NOT provide printed test vouchers for those who do not bring their own)
- Check that your name, test level, test site are correct.

2. Photo ID

- Bring a valid photo ID for identification (e.g., driver's license, student ID with a photo or passport).
- Make sure your name, date of birth, and photo are clearly visible.

3. Stationery and Personal Items

- HB or B Pencils
(Pencil sharpeners will not be provided, so please bring enough sharpened pencils with you)
- Eraser
- Please limit the number of personal items you bring to the test site

4. At the Test Site

- Check your transportation route and travel time to the test site in advance.
- Keep your test voucher and ID ready to show at the entrance.
- Confirm the check-in time and do not arrive earlier than instructed.
- The doors will remain closed after the check-in time has ended, and no one will be allowed to enter for any reason.
- There will be no waiting area for parents or guardians inside the test venue.
- Your ID will also be checked inside the classroom before the test begins. Please **keep your ID with you until the test is finished.**
- If your address has changed, please complete and submit the form at the Information Update Desk on the test day
- Some people are sensitive to strong scents, so we kindly ask all test takers to avoid using perfume or heavily scented products.
- For test takers of the afternoon sessions (N3, N4, and N5), there will be over one hour of waiting between check-in and the start of the tests.
The waiting time will take place in the hall. While waiting in the hall, you are still considered to be inside the test site, so all electronic devices must not be used in accordance with the Japan Foundation's regulations.

Note: As long as you enter the building within the designated check-in period, there will be enough time to complete the registration process—so please don't worry.
